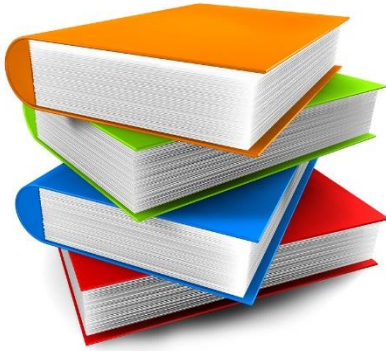


Literacy Week

Our school is celebrating Literacy!
Here are the events that will be taking place
during the week.

Monday, September 28

- Love of Literacy Launch @ Chuck E. Cheese's
 - ☆ Our school is having a fundraiser at Chuck E. Cheese's! This event will be from 4:30-9:00 PM. Students can fill out the boxes on the Chuck E Cheese flyers every day when they read. This will allow them to receive 10 free tokens at arrival.

Tuesday, September 29

- Wear Your Word (Grades 3-8)
 - ☆ Students will have to wear one educational word. Students can figure out how to wear their word on their shirt. Students can either tape it, hang it with a string, or wear it in another creative way.
- Word Parade (Grades K-2)
 - ☆ Our school will put on a "Word Parade!"
 - ☆ Students are to dress up in their vocabulary word costumes (Please see your child's teacher for more information about this activity.)
 - ☆ Since some costumes might be bulky or delicate, the school will parade around campus at the beginning of the day. Parents are welcome to come and watch the parade. Students may bring their school uniforms to change into after the parade.

Wednesday, September 30

- Drop Everything And Read Day
 - ☆ To encourage excitement in reading, the entire school will participate in "Drop Everything And Read" at the same time. Please bring a book to read.
- Dads Take Your Kids to School Day!
 - ☆ Fathers are encouraged to take their children to school on this day!

Thursday, October 1

- School Picture Day!
- Buddy Reading Day
 - ☆ Each homeroom will be paired up with another homeroom of a different level in the school. Students will then be paired up with a buddy to read.
- Donate a Book Day
 - ☆ Students are encouraged to bring in a book for donation to a local charity. More information about the charity will be sent out soon.

Friday, October 2

- Literacy Color Walk at Main Campus!
 - ☆ When is it?: This event will take place on FRIDAY, OCT. 2 in the afternoon.
 - ☆ What is it?: Students will be walking a mile around the field and getting covered in different colors at various "checkpoints" on the course. The funds raised will go towards investing in school literacy improvements.
 - ☆ Cost: It is \$10 to participate. Any student who raises \$25 or more will get a Color Walk t-shirt. The top 3 students who raise the most money will be rewarded with gift cards! Students can record the donations they collect from family and friends on the donation sheet included in the file.
 - ☆ Donations: The school is asking that different grade levels donate items to be sold that day. Remember to bring in receipts with your child's name on it so you can get PAVE hours.
 - ☆ Volunteers: If you are interested in volunteering that day, fill out the volunteer form in the packet and return ASAP. PAVE hours can be given.
 - ☆ Permission Slip: All students must submit a permission slip that is signed and designates YES or NO as to their participation in the event.
 - ☆ Any student who does not participate in this event will have to stay inside and complete classwork.
