Student Arrival Times

- Kindergarten & 1st grade- 8:30 a.m. – 8:45 a.m. (students must be seated and ready to learn by 8:45 a.m.)
- 2nd – 5th grade- 8:00 a.m. – 8:15 a.m. (students must be seated and ready to learn by 8:15 a.m.)
- 6th – 8th grade- 7:30 a.m. – 7:45 a.m. (students must be seated and ready to learn by 7:45 a.m.)

Only on Day 1, K-8 grade parents may drop-off students in their classroom during arrival time. This is for student arrival ONLY.

During dismissal, all students will report to the dismissal area (parent pick-up, bus, After School Care). No parents will be allowed in the building.

Student Dismissal Times

- Kindergarten & 1st grade- 2:45 p.m.
- 2nd – 5th grade- 3:15 p.m.
- 6th – 8th grade- 2:45 p.m.

Wednesday Dismissal Times

- Kindergarten & 1st grade- 2:45 p.m.
- 2nd – 5th grade- 2:15 p.m.
- 6th – 8th grade- 1:45 p.m.

***Please be patient as the traffic line will be slow the first couple days of school. This is for the safety of the children.**

***Please remain in your vehicle for pick-up. Do not park or exit the vehicle.**

Communicate with your child's dismissal teacher with any changes in dismissal procedures (ex: bus, ASC, or parent pick-up).

- If you must drop off your child early, they must be enrolled in the Before School Care Program.

Mandatory School Uniforms
